- To inspire faculty members to explore and experiment with various instructional strategies keeping in view of students' learning abilities.
- To orient the faculty for nurturing graduates of distinction committed to academic and professional excellence and lifelong learning.
- To catalyse the process of generation, dissemination and application of knowledge.
- To mentor faculty members for IPR generation and undertaking projects for the benefit of university, society and country.
- To inculcate highest level of ethical values, integrity and professionalism.
- To update knowledge of faculty members using modern information and research methodology tools.
- To develop knowledge and clinical skills required for performing the role of competent and effective teacher, administrator, researcher and mentor.

FDP RULES & REGULATIONS

- 100% Free (No Registration Fee & No Training Fee)
- Only 50 registered candidates are allowed for FDP (on first-come-first-serve basis)
 from SHUATS
- All candidates should complete online registration through the Registration Link provided in the University website or mentioned in this pamphlet
- Maximum of 5 candidates will be allowed from one College/School
- Online registration will automatically close after 50 candidates completes the registration process
- Timing of FDP (Tentatively): Morning 12:00 noon to 1:00 pm & Afternoon 3:00 pm to 5:00 pm
- Saturday and Sundays are holidays
- 32 Lectures (Theory/Practical Training Sessions) will be conducted in the FPD by the carefully selected experts/subject matter specialists
- Theory Lecture will be of 1 hour duration and Practical/Hands on Training Session will be of 2 hour duration.
- Handout/Lecture Notes will be provided to all participants after the completion of every lecture/practical class
- Online Quiz Test consisting of 10 multiple-choice questions (MCQs) will be conducted every day from previous day lectures/practical class (10 Marks for one quiz)
- Online Comprehensive Test consisting of 50 multiple-choice questions (MCQs) will be conducted at the end of the FDP (from all 32 lectures)
- Online Quiz Test & Online Comprehensive Test will be conducted through the App "Wayground" (formerly Quizizz), so all the participants should bring their own smart phones for the FDP
- Snacks and tea/coffee (free of charge) will be provided in morning session and evening session to all participants
- Attendance is mandatory for the participants and it carries marks. Participant who
 has less than 80% attendance in FDP will not get training certificate
- All participants should strictly follow the rules and regulations of FDP
- Training Certificates will be provided to all participants who successfully complete
 the FDP
